- 1. Regarding taking notes from textbook
 - Read Chapter Summary & Visual Summary
 - Take notes using a method of your choice "that works" (split page,
 Cornell, bold words)
 - Scan chapter for bold words and identification
 - Read chapter and add notes to connect vocab, explain events.
 - Summarize your notes "in your own words"
- 2. Spend 5 minutes every night reviewing your notes (either by reading them, splitting the page as flashcards, or re-writing your notes)
- Use Quizlet to review chapter terms (5 minutes each night) choose format: flashcards, games, etc.
- 4. Create own quizlet or flashcards
- 5. Participate in class by actively taking notes
- 6. Study completed assessments (quiz, test, etc)
- 7. Re-write your chapter notes
- 8. Review Chapter Study Guide from your teacher for each chapter
- 9. Review your textbook for maps
