

EIGHTFOLD PATH COLLAGE/90PTS

Often in Western culture, an emphasis is placed on accumulating material goods, gaining personal power, and achieving material pleasure. In contrast, followers of Buddhism believe that the way to attain enlightenment or nirvana is to follow the Eightfold Path. This is easier said than done as one must constantly make the appropriate choices in life to stay on the correct path to enlightenment.

YOUR TASK:

Examine how society, through the means of the media, poses a challenge for teenagers to stay on the Eightfold Path in order to make correct decisions.

DIRECTIONS:

1. As a group of 4 students you will divide the Eightfold Path so each group member is responsible for 2 steps.

1. Right Views - realize 4 Noble Truths

A. First Noble Truth – life is filled with suffering and sorrow

B. Second Noble Truth –the cause of suffering is people’s selfish desires for temporary pleasures

C. Third Noble Truth – the way to end all suffering is to end all desires

D. Fourth Noble Truth – the way to overcome desires and attain enlightenment is to follow the Eightfold Path, which is called the Middle Way between desires and self-denial

2. Right Intention – commitment to self-improvement

3. Right Speech – no lies, hurtful language

4. Right Action – act kindly, respect others

5. Right Livelihood –earn a living in a decent way

6. Right Effort – without effort, nothing will be achieved

7. Right Mindfulness – realize how things really are (not impacted by previous experiences)

8. Right Concentration – meditation

2. Each group member will be responsible for examining how the media impacts their assigned two steps by means of analyzing popular magazines and cutting out images that correlate with each step. Each image should clearly convey how the media poses a challenge for teenagers to stay on the Eightfold Path. Along side each step of the Eightfold Path will include an image and a one sentence summary to rationalize your choice.

3. Produce one collage per group by following the steps listed below:

- ✓ At the top of the paper label your project “Eightfold Path.”
- ✓ Draw a path (straight or curvy) down the middle of the paper from the top to the bottom. Make sure to leave enough room on each side of the path for a collage and written explanation. Starting at the bottom of the paper create a ladder by dividing your path into eight (8) even sections.
- ✓ Starting at the bottom of the paper label each section of the path in order of the Eightfold Path (follow the same order as listed above!)
- ✓ Create a title at the top of the paper in the left hand section labeled “Challenges.” Create a title at the top of the paper on the right hand section labeled “Explanations.”
- ✓ In the “Challenges” section glue/draw eight images next to the step the image relates to on the Eightfold Path.
- ✓ In the “Explanations” section write a one to two sentence summary next to each step to rationalize your choice of image.

4. HW: Type one comprehensive paragraph(no longer!) open response to the following question: “What challenges do teenagers face today if they were to attempt to follow the Eightfold Path?” Choose any two (2) steps to examine in your response. Your response is NOT limited to just the role of the media but can address the difficulty of following the Eightfold Path as a teenager on a daily basis.

You will be evaluated:

- Individually based on weekly rubric (30) and writing assignment(30)
- As a team based on the finished product & explanation to the class (30)
