

## **AMERINDIAN CIVILIZATIONS IN-CLASS GROUP PRESENTATION (50 POINTS)**

### Procedure:

You and your group will be assigned one Amerindian civilization for which you will make a group presentation/lesson to give to the class.

Circle the civilization(s) to which you are assigned:

1. Olmec & Zapotec: Foundations Period (Ch. 9-2)
2. Chavin, Nazca, & Moche: Foundations Period (Ch. 9-3)
3. Maya: Classical Period (Ch. 16-2)
4. Aztec: Post-Classical Period (Ch. 16-3)
5. Inca: Post-Classical Period (Ch. 16-4)

### Your presentation should include:

- 8 slides in total
  - 1 title slide that includes the name, time period, and dates of the civilization
  - 1 slide for geography of the civilization
  - 1 slide for each of the 5 characteristics of civilization
  - 1 slide explaining 3-5 similarities to other civilizations of its time period
- An overview of the civilization organized by the 5 characteristics of civilization
- At least six (6) visuals (including a map) that enhance the understanding of the information in your text
- At least one (1) lame joke/pun that only Mr. Hoey will find hilarious

### Your presentation should:

- Be shared with me via Google Drive as soon as you begin creating it
- Be well-organized and easy to follow
- Show a complete understanding of your topic
- Involve the participation of each member of your group
- Allow you to answer questions from the class
